She was the founder and first webmaster of Haiga Online (http://www.haigaonline.com/about/about_haigaonline.html): A Journal of Painting and Poetry (1998-2002) and is the author of *The Haiku Habit* (Lone Egret Press, 1996), *Barely Dawn* (Lone Egret Press, 1999), *Berries and Cream: Contemporary Haiga in North America* (Press Here, 2000), a book-length interview with Michael Dylan Welch.
